**Tomi Ungerer**, born in Strasbourg in 1931, landed in New York in 1956 with \$60 in his pocket and with a suitcase full of drawings. Overnight he became a star as a caricaturist, illustrator and children's book author, publishing more than 80 books in ten years. As a graphic artist he created advertising campaigns for Willy Brandt and *The New York Times*. He now divides his time between Strasbourg and Ireland.
