He was previously editor of *Blueprint* and *Domus* magazines, and Director of 'Glasgow 1999: UK City of Architecture and Design' and the 2002 Venice Architectural Biennale. Former architecture critic for the *Observer*, he has written several books, including *The 100 Mile City* (1992), and *John Pawson: Themes and Projects*, *John Pawson Works* and *Future Systems*, published by Phaidon.
